Venture Program Application Process

The Venture Program Application Process includes the following steps:

STEP 1: COMPLETE the following documents and return them to Melissa Beidler, Director of Enrollment, along with the Family Application and registration fee(s).

- Part A: Student Application – completed by student
Students not currently attending HMS: please attach most recent grade report
- Part B: Student Covenant – signed by student and by parent
- Part C: Student Survey – short essay questions & self-assessment completed by student
- Part D: Student References – Ask the following people to complete a reference form and return by it by email or in a sealed envelope directly to Melissa Beidler, HMS Director of Enrollment:
 - a) Parent
 - b) Pastor or youth group leader
 - c) Current math teacher
 - d) Teacher from another core subject (English, science, history, etc.)
 - e) If a student has received support services: an additional reference from the support teacher is required.

STEP 2: REVIEW – The application will be reviewed by the Venture Program team.

STEP 3: INTERVIEW – We will schedule an interview with the student and parents
